
## What are Serious Games?













A serious game is a specific type of game.


A serious game can be:

- Tell out loud the history of a task and help to do the task.









- Interactivity\_because it gives an immediate response to players.

- Being adapted to each person needs.






The way people with intellectual disabilities are supported may not be in the way they need.


Serious games can be a better way to support and train.
